

# THE JUMPMASER SYSTEM

## RULES:

### NATIONAL HUNT RACING ONLY

1/ Novice hurdles only considered – BUT NOT HANDICAP novice hurdles.  
To clarify – The title of the race must contain the words NOVICES HURDLE.

2/ Maximum number of runners – 13

3/ The selection is forecast favourite PROVIDED the forecast price is at any price odds on up and including even money ( I.E if the forecast price is above evens – no bet )

The rules, then, are incredibly simple. However by applying the above three rules jumpmaster has produced 48 winners and just 6 losers from 54 bets in an 8 month period from July 2005 to February. With such a good strike rate, I see no point in looking for further filters which may eliminate some of the six losers, as this would probably also eliminate winners.

As you will see from the results list, the average price of the winners are around 4/6. Theoretically and mathematically this means that a horse has a 60% chance of winning. Jumpmasters win rate is around the 90% mark – 50% higher than the theoretically expected win rate.  
The 10% bank plan works very well, or running on doubles, trebles and even four timers.

The betting forecast in the Daily Mail is the paper I use for the horses expected starting price but I do believe that any Newspaper will work.  
I also know that the actual live market has just a high strike rate of winners.
